Customs & Immigration Service Restriction on the Importation and Exportation of 1-benzylpiperazine ('BZP')

Using the powers delegated to him by the Minister for Home Affairs under the Customs and Excise (Import and Export Control) (Jersey) Order 2006 the Agent of the Impôts has issued a new Open General Import Licence and a new Open General Export Licence effective from 19th September 2008.

1-benzylpiperazine also known as 1-benzyl-1,4-diazacyclohexane N-benzylpiperazine or less precisely as benzylpiperazine or 'BZP' has been added to the list of goods in the Open General Import Licence that require a specific Import Licence and to the list of goods in the Open General Export Licence that require a specific Export licence. As a consequence this substance may only be lawfully imported or exported from the island under the authority of a specific licence issued by or on behalf of the Minister of Home Affairs. This restriction has immediate effect.
